From the Marshal of the Horse

Unto the Good People of Trimaris your servant, Lady Chiere wreic Maredudd, by Their Majesties Will the new Trimarian Marshal of the Horse does send greetings.

First, I wish to thank the Honorable Lady Aurora Danielle Tevelyan, my predecessor in this office, for her trust in my knowledge and abilities as witnessed by her recommendation unto Their Majesties. I hope to serve half as well for twice as long as she in this position and hope that her trust is well placed.

Second, I wish to thank Lord Gavin and Lady Morigan and their crew down in Ft. Myers for the example they have set in their drive and determination to further the equestrian program here in Trimaris. As my predecessor praised my efforts with the Starhaven Equestrian group, I hereby acknowledge Lord Gavin and Lady Morigan's efforts as the inspiration for mine own and others efforts in Starhaven. I look forward to working with the Mongols, as well as all other equestrians, both within and without the Kingdom, during my tenure in this office.

Now, to get down to business: As may be expected with any change in Kingdom Office, with a new Kingdom Equestrian Officer there will be some changes in the Trimarian Cavalry, or at least how some things are done.

The first order of business is to refresh the roles of the Authorized Marshals, Ground Crew, and Riders. Much as the Heavy and Light Weapon's Fighter authorizations are periodically redone, so too shall the Equestrian Authorizations. To that end, all authorized Equestrian Marshals, Ground Crew, and Riders (of all levels) are hereby notified that their current Authorization Cards will become void as of Spring Crown, February 19, 2005. All those who wish to retain their authorization must submit a copy of their current authorization card and proof of membership to this office. If all appropriate paperwork (i.e. waivers, etc) is still on file, a new card will be issued. If there is any paperwork missing, the new Authorization Card will not be issued until the new paperwork is filled out and turned in. If you are planning on participating in the equestrian activities at Gulf Wars, note that you should plan on submitting your existing card as soon as possible, for Spring Crown Lyst will be the last opportunity before the War to receive your new card.

There are several positions within the Cavalry that I will be filling over the next several months. These include the Dean of the Equestrian College, the Kingdom Groundsman, and the Secretary. Anyone interested in filling any of these positions should contact me as soon as possible. The King's Lancer, who for the last several years has been Honorable Lady Brenna MacGrioghair, is being split into two positions. It would be my honor to continue Honorable Lady Brenna as the King's Lancer, wherein she will continue to fulfill the responsibilities as the Cavalries liaison with the Equestrians from out-of-kingdom. The administrative responsibilities once belonging to the King's Lancer will form the core responsibilities of a new position, yet to be named, that will be held by my Lord Husband, Brehyr Maredudd ap Cynan. Finally, the Hippatariar, an office also filled by the Honorable Lady Brenna, I again leave safely in her hands. Please stay tuned for any further changes to the organization of the Trimarian Cavalry.

To close this note, I want to thank all those who came out for the Romance of the Rose: An Equestrian Adventure, hosted by Starhaven in early November and I hope to see you all at the Emprise of the Azure Rose in January.
