These laws are issued this 17th day of April, AS XLIII being 2009 Gregorian.

I. General

A. Pre-Existing Law

1. All prior Greater Kingdom Laws not listed in this publication of law are hereby repealed.
2. Trimaris Kingdom Law will be divided into two levels: Greater and Lesser Kingdom Law
3. Greater and Lesser Laws of Trimaris are subject to mundane law, the Organizational Handbook and the By-Laws of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. The reader is instructed to refer to the Organization Handbook in its entirety for further study and understanding of topics covered by these Laws.

B. Changes to Greater Law

1. The Crown of Trimaris is the protector and patron of these laws. The Crown has the sole right and privilege to propose amendments to Kingdom Law, and after consultation, make official changes to Kingdom Law. The Crown of Trimaris is defined as both the Sovereign and Consort speaking as one voice.
2. In the case of extensive revisions of Great Kingdom Law, a notice in the Kingdom newsletter alerting the populace to proposed changes and directing them to the Kingdom's website will meet the burden of I:B:3
 - a) Any notice published in the Kingdom newsletter pursuant to I:B:3 will include the following: "Those members of the Society for Creative Anachronism who wish to do so may contact the Kingdom Chronicler for a paper copy of the proposed law changes, to be mailed at the Kingdom's expense."
 - b) Any member of the Society of Creative Anachronism may request a written copy of the proposed law changes referred to in the notice at the Kingdom's expense.
3. Proposed amendments, additions, or changes to Greater Kingdom Law must be published in the Kingdom newsletter, Talewinds.
 - a) Amendments to Greater Kingdom Law to correct typographical errors, renumbering, or that do not substantive change the meaning of the law, need not be published for commentary.
4. Correspondence concerning the proposed amendment will be accepted by the Crown for a period of eight weeks.
5. After review of the correspondence by the Crown and review of the laws themselves by the Kingdom Seneschal for conflict with Corpora, Corporate Bylaws, and mundane law, the proposed amendment may become Law.
6. Any new law enacted by the Crown must be proclaimed at an official event and published in the Kingdom newsletter, Talewinds, at the earliest opportunity. The published change must contain the date and event at which the new law was proclaimed.

C. Interpretation

1. Interpretation of Kingdom Law is the duty of the Crown and the Kingdom Seneschal in consensus. Application of the Law is based upon good will and common sense; against such there is no Law.

D. Publication

1. All changes to The Greater and Lesser Kingdom Laws of Trimaris will be published in the Kingdom newsletter and at least once every three (3) years an updated Kingdom Law will be published in its entirety.

II. Royalty

A. General

1. The rights, duties, privileges and responsibilities of the Crown are detailed in the Organizational Handbook of the SCA Inc.
2. Royal Presence
 - a) The Royal Presence will be defined as the area ten feet in radius around the Sovereign, Consort, Heirs, Thrones, Crowns, Coronets or Sword of State.
 - b) No person will enter the Royal Presence without rendering proper courtesy to the Crown.
 - c) No persons save armigers will bear weapons in the Royal Presence without prior leave of the Crown, or Heirs where applicable.
3. For the duration of Their reign, the King and Queen will be protectors and honorary members of every active Trimarian order with the all the associated privileges except for voting on new members in the case of polling orders.
4. Prohibitions
 - a) No member of Royalty will bestow any award upon their own person.
 - b) Any changes which may financially benefit the crown will become active at the beginning of the next reign.
 - c) No member of Royalty will hold any other office as defined in the Organizational Handbook during their tenure.

B. The Crown

1. Succession
 - a) In the event one of the ruling monarchs becomes unable to fulfill their duties, the remaining monarch will continue to rule for the normal duration of the reign with the full rights of the Crown.
 - b) In the event both ruling monarchs become unable to fulfill their duties, a Regent will be named.
 - (1) If possible, the Royal Heirs will act as Regents of the Kingdom.
 - (2) If there are no Royal Heirs, the Kingdom Seneschal will act as Regent of the Kingdom.
 - (3) If needed, the Regent will call and hold a Crown Tournament within six weeks. The winner and consort will be immediately crowned by the most recent last sovereign in attendance, excluding the immediately past sovereign.
 - (4) During the interim in which a new Crown is pending, the Regent will act with only those Royal Powers critical to the operation of the Kingdom. In no case may a Regent change Kingdom Law, Kingdom Financial Policy, or bestow any award.
2. Powers
 - a) The Crown will serve as the final avenue of appeal within the Kingdom of Trimaris for any sanction imposed by any officer of the Kingdom.
 - b) Unless specifically stated otherwise, any action or circumstance may be allowed or disallowed at the will of the Crown.

C. The Royal Heirs

1. Succession
 - a) In the event the Royal Heirs become unable or ineligible to fulfill Their duties, The Kingdom Seneschal will call for a Crown Tournament to be held as soon as possible.
 - b) The victor and consort will be crowned Prince and Princess immediately upon the conclusion of the tournament.
2. Powers
 - a) The Royal Heirs may, with the prior written consent of the Crown, bestow any award except elevation to the Peerage Orders, or Augmentations of Arms.
 - b) The written consent of the Crown will include the name of the recipient, as well as the specific award to be given.
3. Royal Files
 - a) The Royal Heirs will have access to all Royal Kingdom files upon request to the Crowns. A date and time

will be set convenient to all parties concerned.

D. Crown Tournament

1. Format

- a) Crown Tournament will be conducted by heavy weapons combat.
- b) The specific format and style of the tournament will be published in the Kingdom newsletter at least one month in advance.
- c) If not specifically stated otherwise, the tourney will be double elimination, best 2 out of 3 for the finals.

2. Requirements

- a) Each prospective competitor and consort must meet the Royal lists entry requirements as set forth in the Organizational Handbook, and be willing and able to fulfill the duties of the Crown.
- b) Each fighter and consort must physically reside within the borders of Trimaris for at least one year preceding entry into the list.
- c) Each fighter and consort must have read and be familiar with the Organizational Handbook and Trimaris Kingdom Law.
- d) In accordance with the Organizational handbook, the Kingdom Seneschal will take such steps as are necessary to ensure that each competitor and consort is a member of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. (grammar: "each" is not plural)
- e) Each prospective competitor must present him- or herself in appropriate armor and weaponry at the start of Crown Tourney.
- f) All participants must be acceptable to the Crown and must be willing to swear fealty or affirm allegiance prior to participation in Crown Tournament.
- g) Any Kingdom Officer wishing to enter Crown Tourney must designate in writing to the Crown the person who will replace him or her should that Officer win the Crown 15 (business) days prior to Crown Lyst. The replacement must be acceptable to the present Crown. The letter designating the replacement must also be signed by the prospective replacement.

III. Territorial Nobility

A. Powers

1. The Territorial Baron and Baroness will preside over Baronial events and may hold Baronial Courts.
2. The Territorial Baron and Baroness may establish a maximum of four awards, one of which will be armigerous and three non-armigerous, which will be specific to their Barony.
 - a) Additionally, the Territorial Baron and Baroness may establish one non-armigerous award for each Canton of their Barony, which will be specific to the Canton.
3. The Baron and Baroness, as representatives of the Crown, will have the right to bestow and Award of Arms along with the armigerous Baronial award in consultation with the Crown.

B. Restrictions

1. The Baron and Baroness will swear an oath of fealty or affirm allegiance in person or in writing to each incoming Crown at their Coronation or soon thereafter.
 - a. All Territorial Barons/Baronesses not swearing fealty to the Crown will be considered inactive by the Crown and all right and responsibilities of the Office will revert to the Crown until such time as fealty is sworn to the Crown.
2. A Baron and Baroness may serve for three (3) years in succession.
 - a. Their tenure may be extended for up to an additional one (1) year at the discretion of the Crown, in rare or extraordinary circumstances.
3. The Crown may remove a Baron/Baroness for just cause.

C. Succession

1. At the conclusion of the tenure of the reigning Baronial nobles, the Crown will solicit nominations for the incoming Baronial nobles from the outgoing Baronial nobles, and the populace of the Barony.
2. At the conclusion of the nomination period, the Crown will direct the Kingdom Seneschal to conduct a

polling of the Barony.

- a) No polling will include less than two candidates without the express written permission of the Crown.
 - b) The Kingdom Seneschal will verify the eligibility of the nominees, and their willingness to serve if chosen by the Crown.
 - c) Each polling will include a space next to each candidate that can be marked in numerical order of preference, and an area for commentary on each candidate.
 - d) The Baronial seneschal will cause the postmark deadline of the polling to be published in the Baronial newsletter.
3. The polling will be sent to the address of record for every paid member of the Society residing within the established borders of the Barony.
 - a) The Polling will be sent to paid members of the barony. Polling forms may also be requested from the Kingdom or Baronial Seneschal.
 - b) The Kingdom Seneschal will provide a list of all persons receiving the polling to the Crown for the purpose of validation of the returned polling.
 4. All polling responses will be sent directly to the Crown, or Their chosen representative.

IV. Chivalry

1. Fealty will be sworn to the Crown of Trimaris by all Knights residing within the borders of Trimaris at Coronation or the first event that the Crown and Knight attend following the Crown's Coronation.
2. Failure to do so may result in mandatory banishment from the Royal Presence, and surrendering of the gold chain and white belt to the acting Principal of the Order until such time as fealty is re-sworn or the Reign ends.
3. Such is the will of the Knights of Trimaris.

V. Grievance Procedure

1. Any person having a grievance will attempt to work through the problem with the parties involved in person.
2. In the event face to face conflict resolution is unsuccessful, any potential complainant will attempt to work through the problem with the parties involved in writing.
3. In the event written conflict resolution is unsuccessful, any potential complainant will contact the officer most directly in charge of the area or activity in dispute in writing, and will carbon copy all principal parties involved.
4. In the event the officer is unable to resolve the conflict, any potential complainant will contact the Kingdom Officer in charge of the area or activity in dispute in writing, and will carbon copy the local officer, and all principal parties involved.
5. In the event that the Kingdom officer is unable to resolve the conflict, any potential complainant will contact the Kingdom Seneschal in writing and will carbon copy the Kingdom Officer, the local officer and all principal parties involved.
6. In the event the Kingdom Seneschal is unable to resolve the conflict, any potential complainant will contact the Crown of Trimaris in writing, and will carbon copy the Kingdom Seneschal, the Kingdom Officer, the local officer, and all principal parties involved.

VI. Courts of Chivalry

A. General

1. Courts of Chivalry within the Kingdom of Trimaris will be for the purpose of investigation into matters within the medieval framework of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc.
2. Courts of Chivalry pertain only to conduct and matters within the structure and definitions of the Society.
3. All other avenues available for settling a matter will be exhausted before a Court of Chivalry is convened.
4. The Earl Marshal and Kingdom Seneschal will have the responsibility for the convening of all Courts of

Chivalry in the Kingdom.

- a) If a Court of Chivalry is convened wherein the Earl Marshal or Kingdom Seneschal is the subject of the inquiry, the Crown will appoint a Peer of the Realm to assume the duties assigned to the Earl Marshal or the Kingdom Seneschal by these laws.

B. Notification

1. Any person or group desiring that a Court of Chivalry be convened for any reason will petition the Kingdom Seneschal, Earl Marshal and the Crown in writing. The petition will include the following information:
 1. The name of the petitioner
 2. The name of the proposed subject of the Court
 3. The nature of the charge(s)
 4. The names of the witnesses against the subject
 5. The nature of the evidence against the subject
2. The Kingdom Seneschal and Earl Marshal will examine the petition and present it to the Crown with advice as to whether the evidence warrants a formal Court of Chivalry.
 - a) If it is determined that the evidence does not warrant a formal Court, the matter may be settled in a lesser manner; for example: by means of a reprimand, or by referring the matter to the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal.
 - b) If it is determined that the evidence does warrant a formal Court of Chivalry, the Earl Marshal will convene the Court as provided for by these Laws.
3. If a Court of Chivalry is to be convened, the Kingdom Seneschal will notify the subject by certified mail that the Court of Chivalry is to be convened, and will include the following information:
 1. A copy of the petition
 2. A list of the formal charges to be brought before the Court
 3. A list of four proposed dates and places for the Court to be held, spanning not less than four weeks and not more than 8 weeks
 4. A copy of this law (containing the procedures for the hearing of the case) and any other laws pertaining to the case
 5. The nature of the evidence against the subject
 - a) The dates will fall on a Saturday or Sunday during a Society event within Trimaric.
 - b) An event may be scheduled for the Court of Chivalry, if necessary.
4. The Kingdom Seneschal will also send a copy of the letter of notification to the subject's local seneschal to ensure notification.
 - a) If the subject's address is unknown and cannot be determined, then this notification will suffice; the seneschal will then make reasonable attempts to notify the subject including general announcements at the local meetings.
5. The subject will have two weeks to reply either from the date that the notification was mailed, or, if the subject's address is unknown, from the date of the general announcement at the local meeting.
6. The subject will choose one of the four proposed dates and places for the convening of the Court of Chivalry.
 - a) If the subject of the Court fails to respond within the period specified by these laws, the Earl Marshal will select one of the proposed dates and places. The Kingdom Seneschal will also notify the subject in writing as to when and where the Court of Chivalry will be held with or without the subject's attendance.
 - b) In the unusual circumstance that none of the proposed dates and places are acceptable, the subject will petition the Earl Marshal and the Crown in writing within ten (10) business days of being notified of the Court of Chivalry, to request another date and place. The granting of said petition will be at the discretion of the Crown.
7. The populace will be notified of the convening of the Court of Chivalry.
 - a) The notification will include the name of the subject of the Court of Chivalry, the charges, the date, and the place the Court of Chivalry will be convened.
 - b) Courts of Chivalry will be open to the populace.

C. Procedure

1. On the day of the Court of Chivalry a jury will be chosen at random from those Peers of the Realm who are present. The jury will be comprised of at least six members.
2. The Crown will preside over a Court of Chivalry
 - a) The Crown may appoint a Peer of the Realm to preside in Their name.
 - b) In cases where the proceedings of a Court of Chivalry extend into the next Reign, the following Crown may re-appoint the former presiding peer to continue in that office to preserve the continuity of the Court proceedings.
3. The composition of a Court of Chivalry and the procedure followed in presenting evidence will be at the discretion of the Crown, Kingdom Seneschal, and Earl Marshal, subject to the restrictions of the Laws of the Kingdom.
4. The Earl Marshal will cause a complete record of the proceedings of the Court of Chivalry to be made by whatever means is determined to be most efficient and reliable.
 - a) A copy of this record will be made available to the subject of the Court of Chivalry.
5. The subject of the Court of Chivalry will be permitted to be represented and advised by counsel as he or she chooses.
 - a) The Crown will appoint a Peer of the Realm acceptable to the subject to aid in his or her defense if the subject so requests.
6. The subject of the Court of Chivalry will have the right to present evidence and call witnesses in presenting his or her defense.
7. Upon the conclusion of the case, the jury will present to the Crown its recommendation for the disposition of the case.
8. The final decision as to what, if any, action(s) will be taken in resolving the case before the Court of Chivalry rests with the Crown.
9. The subject of a Court of Chivalry may appeal any resulting sanction to the Board of Directors of the Society in the manner specified by the Organizational Handbook.

VII. Officers of the Kingdom

A. General

1. All Officers must be members of the SCA, Inc., with immediate access to the Kingdom newsletter, and must maintain this membership while in Office.
2. Officers at any level may be warranted for a period not to exceed two years.
 - a) The warrants of all Greater & Lesser Kingdom Officers must be signed by the Crown and by the appropriate superior Officer where such exists.
3. All official communication will be in writing.
 - a) Anonymous communication of any kind will not be acceptable at any level.
 - b) All Officers of Trimaris will respond in writing to official correspondence within fifteen (15) business days of receipt.
4. All Official files of all Greater, Lesser, and Local officers of the Kingdom will be open to the populace upon request, excluding only those files which must legally be kept confidential.
5. The Kingdom Seneschal will ensure that every officer (Greater and Lesser) prior to the turnover of their office, will conduct a review of the offices files and purge any unnecessary documents.
 - a) Unnecessary documents will be defined as, multiple copies of the same document, such documents not required by Corpora, Kingdom Law, the operation of the office or of a historical value as determined by the officer responsible.

B. Greater Kingdom Officers

1. General

- a) Kingdom Officers, in concurrence with the Crown, shall appoint and warrant such lesser officers, deputies, and local officers as is necessary to operate their office within the Kingdom.

- b) All Kingdom Officers shall issue reports to the Crown, Kingdom Seneschal, and their local officers on a quarterly basis at minimum.
 - (1) Local officers shall report quarterly to their Kingdom Superior officers, unless more frequent reporting is required.
 - (2) Within 15 (business) days after Crown Lyst all Greater and Lesser Kingdom Officers shall present to the Crown Prince and Princess a written report on the state of their office, including their names, addresses, and phone numbers, and those of the deputies to their Office.
 - c) All Kingdom officers shall be required to attend one Kingdom Coronation, one Crown Tourney, one Arts and Sciences Faire, plus one other of these events per calendar year after their appointment, for the purpose of conducting meetings for their subordinate Officers.
 - d) All Greater Kingdom Officers shall be responsible for training, warranting, and reporting of lesser and local officers.
 - e) Kingdom officers are required to provide the Kingdom Seneschal, and their lesser and local officers with current copies of all manuals or handbooks concerning their office.
 - f) Greater Kingdom Officers are members of the Kingdom Financial committee and are responsible for approving and implementing the Annual Budget. Other responsibilities include approving non-budget, non-event and non-administrative expenses over \$500.00 and submitting proposals for changes to the Financial Policy.
2. The Kingdom Seneschal
- a) The Kingdom Seneschal shall be the chief administrative officer of the Kingdom, and shall be responsible to the Crown, Royal Heirs, and other officers in such a manner as to ensure the efficient operation of the Kingdom.
 - b) The Kingdom Seneschal shall be responsible for ensuring the warranting of Kingdom officers, in conjunction with the Crown.
 - c) As the supreme autocrat, the Kingdom Seneschal shall oversee the planning of Kingdom events, and shall solicit the cooperation of other Kingdom Officers as may be required to assure the proper functioning of such events.
 - d) The Kingdom Seneschal shall be responsible for maintaining the calendar of all events throughout Trimaris, and shall see to its timely publishing in the Kingdom newsletter, Talewinds.
 - e) The Kingdom Seneschal shall maintain a listing of the zip codes belonging to each group within the Kingdom.
 - f) The Kingdom Seneschal shall maintain the official copy of Kingdom law, and shall furnish a copy of Kingdom Law to the Royal Heirs upon winning Crown Tournament.
 - g) The Kingdom Seneschal shall oversee the lesser offices of Minister of Children, Minister of Estates and Constable.
3. The Triskele Herald
- a) The Triskele Herald shall be the principal herald of the Kingdom of Trimaris.
 - b) The Triskele Herald shall keep the Seal of the Triskele Herald for use on award scrolls, and/or appoint a person within the Herald's Office to whom it will be entrusted.
 - c) The Triskele Herald shall issue reports to the Kingdom College of Heralds and local heralds on at least a quarterly basis.
 - d) The Triskele Herald shall be responsible for overseeing heraldic education, device submissions, the Order of Precedence, commenting, and all other heraldically-related matters.
 - e) The Triskele Herald, or their designated representative, shall be the Voice of the Crown when directed.
4. The Earl Marshal
- a) The Earl Marshal shall have authority and responsibility concerning all matters of the Marshalate activities in the Kingdom.
 - b) The Earl Marshal shall act as the Crown's representative when on the field on combat to ensure adherence to the Rules of the List for the Society and Kingdom.
 - c) The Earl Marshal shall establish and maintain the procedures for correct training of combatants in

- Trimaris and be responsible for the training, conduct and warranting of local branch marshals.
- d) Shall oversee the authorization of all areas of martial activity in Trimaris and maintain and promulgate rules of combat, published as “Trimarian Marshalate Rules: Supplemental to Society Rules.”
 - e) The Earl Marshal may for just cause impose such marshal sanction as they may deem necessary and appropriate, including the suspension or revocation of a combatants fighting authorization.
 - f) The Earl Marshal shall oversee the lesser offices of Minister of Equestrian Affairs, Minister of the Lists, Rapier Marshal, Combat Archery Marshal, Target Archery Ranger, Live Weapons Ranger, Youth Combat and any other deputies deemed necessary.
5. The Minister of Arts and Sciences
- a) The Minister of Arts and Sciences shall be responsible for the fostering of the Arts and Sciences in the Kingdom of Trimaris.
 - b) The Minister of Arts and Sciences shall regularly sponsor classes, symposia, and other educational seminars in conjunction with Trimarian Royal University.
 - c) The Minister of Arts and Sciences shall coordinate activities at the Kingdom Art-Science Fairs.
 - d) The Minister of Arts and Sciences shall oversee the Lesser Office of Trimarian Royal University Chancellor.
6. The Kingdom Exchequer
- a) The Kingdom Exchequer shall be responsible for all withdrawals and collections of all Kingdom moneys. All accounts in the Treasurer’s keeping shall require the signature of the Kingdom Seneschal and Kingdom Exchequer. In an emergency, the Kingdom Seneschal and Exchequer may designate a deputy to assume this duty.
 - b) The Kingdom Exchequer shall maintain all financial records of the Kingdom, including any transactions through the Kingdom accounts.
 - c) The Kingdom Exchequer shall maintain the official copy of the Kingdom Financial Policy, and shall provide a copy to the Royal Heirs upon winning Crown Tournament.
 - d) The Kingdom Exchequer shall submit a Quarterly Statement of Kingdom Funds to the Crown and to the Greater Kingdom Officers.
 - e) The Kingdom Exchequer shall issue an annual statement to the Crown, Great Officers, and Talewinds on the financial status of the Kingdom of Trimaris as a whole.
 - f) Shall appoint such deputies as deemed necessary to aid the Office of the Treasurer with the duties and responsibilities of the Office, and shall be responsible for the warranting of local officers.
 - g) The Kingdom Exchequer shall handle all funds in accordance to Kingdom Financial Policy and Society Financial Policy.
 - h) The Kingdom Exchequer shall oversee the lesser office of Royal Chamberlain and Emporium
7. The Kingdom Chronicler
- a) The Kingdom Chronicler shall be responsible for all official publications of the Kingdom of Trimaris. This includes the monthly Kingdom newsletter Talewinds, the Arts and Sciences supplement Triskele and Kingdom Law and other documents as needed.
 - b) The Kingdom Chronicler shall be responsible for the publication of event information and the calendar of events.
 - c) The Kingdom Chronicler or an appointed representative shall keep the minutes of all Kingdom Officer Meetings and Royal Curias.
 - d) The Kingdom Chronicler shall be responsible for handling the financial responsibility of the Office, including all accounting of income from corporate stipend and other sources, and for the reporting of income and expenditures as may be required by the Corporate Treasurer.
 - e) The Kingdom Chronicler shall oversee the lesser offices of Triskele Editor, Historian, Librarian and Webminister.
8. The Kingdom Chirurgeon
- a) While organized first aid services are desirable at events, the Kingdom and its branches may not be placed in the position of requiring or promising these services. Requiring the presence of a medical officer at

events is strictly prohibited per the Corporate Policies of the SCA, Inc

- b) The Kingdom Chirurgeon shall be responsible for organizing voluntary first aid services at Kingdom events and for coordinating the voluntary activities of the Kingdom Chirurgeons.
- c) The Kingdom Chirurgeon shall be responsible for providing basic first aid at Kingdom events to those participants that willingly solicit such assistance and shall at no time forcibly impose first aid services on unwilling parties.
- d) The Kingdom Chirurgeon shall notify the Event Steward, Kingdom Seneschal or Crown of potential health and safety concerns, and such other related activities.
- e) Minors may not be treated for any non-life threatening injury at an event without a parent or a guardian with a properly-executed Medical Authorization Form for Minors designating them as the adult person present at the event as able to authorize medical treatment for that minor in the case of any emergency.
- f) The Kingdom Chirurgeon shall maintain a record of all injuries reported in the Kingdom of Trimaris, and shall act to ensure the confidentiality of those reports as outlined in the Healthcare Information Privacy Act (HIPA) guidelines.

9. Kingdom Hospitaller

- a) The Kingdom Hospitaller shall be responsible for overseeing the instruction of newcomers in the structure, protocol and courtesies of the Society, by holding at least one new-comers' class at each Kingdom event.
- b) The Kingdom Hospitaller shall assist newcomers by serving as a resource of general information about conduct and activities at events and making loaner garb and feast gear available to them.
- c) The Kingdom Hospitaller shall be responsible for the training and appointment of local officers as necessary. Each group of shire level or above must have a Hospitaller, or the group seneschal shall perform the duties of the office.
- d) The Kingdom Hospitaller shall conduct recruitment activities in the Kingdom.
- e) The Kingdom Hospitaller shall report to the Kingdom Seneschal.

C. Lesser Kingdom Officers

1. Minister of Children

- a) The Minister of Children shall provide planned, historically interesting activities and entertainment for children.
 - (1) Such activities shall not be construed as a "baby-sitting" service at events.
- b) All activities must be supervised by at least two unrelated adults.
- c) The Minister of Children shall report to the Kingdom Seneschal.
- d) The Minister of Children and their local officers must have completed the Background Check procedures as required by the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. prior to assuming office.

2. Kingdom Constable

- a) The Constable shall oversee the security of event sites, including Gate security
- b) The Constable shall collect, inventory, store/disburse, unclaimed items lost or found at events.
- c) The Constable shall train and appoint local officers as necessary.
- d) The Constable shall report to the Kingdom Seneschal.

3. Kingdom Chamberlain

- a) The Kingdom Chamberlain will have custody and maintenance of the Royal Regalia when it is not in use by the Crown.
- b) The Kingdom Chamberlain will have an acceptable storage facility located near their place of residence (if necessary) available to maintain the Royal Regalia.
- c) The Kingdom Chamberlain will maintain a written inventory of the Regalia, and keep records of the distribution and the return of Regalia used by the Crown and provide the Royal Heirs and Kingdom Exchequer with a copy of the inventory at the conclusion of the Crown Tournament.
- d) The Kingdom Chamberlain will report to the Kingdom Exchequer.

4. Rapier Marshal, Combat Archery Marshal, Captain of the Rangers, Minister of the Lists, Minister of Equestrian Affairs, Youth Combat and Live weapons Ranger

- a) These Marshals will facilitate and promote their area of marshal activity within Trimaris.
 - b) They will, with the Earl Marshal, train and warrant local officers within their area of marshal activity.
 - c) They will, with the Earl Marshal, be responsible for the authorization of combatants/participants within their area of marshal activity.
 - d) They will be responsible for maintaining supplemental marshalate rules within their area of marshal activity, in concurrence with Earl Marshal.
 - e) They will report quarterly to the Earl Marshal and any direct corporate officer.
 - f) The Youth Combat Marshal and their local officers must have completed the Background Check procedures as required by the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. prior to assuming office.
5. Office of the Emporium
- a) The Office of the Emporium shall be responsible for all goods assigned to its inventory and moneys collected through sales of those goods.
 - (1) All moneys thus collected shall be turned over to the Kingdom Exchequer, together with records of these collections and current inventories of all merchandise.
6. Historian
- a) The Historian will be responsible for the gathering of information pertinent to the activities and events of potential historical importance as may occur within Trimaris.
 - b) The Historian will maintain records and files of such information gathered, and will use this information in such a way as to encourage public interest in the Kingdom's heritage.
 - c) The Historian will be responsible for providing a "History of Trimaris" display at least one Kingdom event per year.
 - d) The Historian will be custodian of the "Book of Kings" for the Kingdom and make it available at each Trimarian coronation when requested by the crown or heirs.
 - e) The Historian will report to the Kingdom Chronicler.
7. Kingdom Webminister
- a) The Kingdom Webminister will be the authoritative advisor to the Kingdom in matters concerning the Internet.
 - b) The duties of the Kingdom Webminister are to maintain the trimaris.org website, the kingdom email forwarders and to monitor the websites of the local groups of Trimaris to make sure they are in compliance with Society and Kingdom policies.
 - c) Webministers of the local groups will report to the Kingdom Webminister.
 - d) The Kingdom Webminister will report to the Kingdom Chronicler.
8. Triskele Editor
- a) The Triskele Editor will be responsible for the production of the Arts and Sciences supplement of Talewinds called Triskele.
 - b) Every attempt will be made to publish twice a year a new issue of Triskele.
 - c) The Triskele Editor will report to the Kingdom Chronicler.
9. Kingdom Librarian
- a) The Kingdom Librarian will report to the Kingdom Chronicler.
10. Trimarian Royal University Chancellor
- a) Trimarian Royal University Chancellor will oversee the registrar of the Trimarian Royal University.
 - b) Trimarian Royal University Chancellor will report to the Kingdom Minister of Arts and Science.

VIII. Recognition and Advancement of Subsidiary Groups

A. Advancement

- 1. A branch is a group within a Kingdom which is administered by the Kingdom directly or indirectly through a principality (all groups) or a barony (cantons).
- 2. The establishment of incipient groups is the responsibility of the Kingdom Seneschal with concurrence of the Crown.
- 3. The boundaries of incipient groups will be set according to the preference and participation of the SCA, Inc.,

members most directly affected by the boundary location.

- a) Such boundaries must be agreeable to close neighboring groups, and must be approved by the Kingdom Seneschal and the Crown, and/or the Society Seneschal, Inc., and Board of Directors when applicable.
4. Petitions for changes in status that affect the territory of a barony or province will be routed through the ruling nobles and seneschal of that group for their comments.

IX. Events

A. Scheduling

1. There will be two Crown Tourneys each calendar year, one in May (Memorial Day) and one in November (second weekend).
2. There will be two Coronations each calendar year, one in March (third or fourth weekend) and one in September (Labor Day).
3. There will be two Arts and Sciences Faires each year, one during each Reign. These will be organized and administered by the office of the Kingdom Minister of Arts and Sciences.
4. After consultation with the Crown, the Kingdom Seneschal may make exceptions to the scheduled dates of Kingdom events when circumstances are warranted. Calendared local events may not be superseded without consultation with the Crown, Seneschal and local group
5. The Kingdom Seneschal will take whatever steps are necessary to ensure the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. classifies all Kingdom events as "official" events.

X. Armorial Rights, Awards, and Honors

A. Arms of the Kingdom

1. The Arms of the Kingdom will be: Argent, on a fess wavy between two triskeles azure a crown of five points, each point tipped with a mullet, argent, between overall a laurel wreath counterchanged.
2. The arms of Trimaris are those of the King and may be borne or displayed only by the King or with the King's permission.
 - a) The Arms of the Sovereign's Heir will be: Argent, on a fess wavy azure between a label throughout dovetailed and a triskele azure a crown of five points, each point tipped with a mullet argent.
3. The Arms of the Consort will be: Argent, on a fess wavy between in pale two triskeles azure, a crown of five points, each point ensigned of a mullet, between in fess two roses argent, all between five roses, two, two and one, azure.
4. The arms of the Consort may be borne or displayed only by the Consort or with the Consort's permission.
 - a) The Arms of the Consort's Heir will be: Argent, on a fess wavy between in pale two triskeles azure, a crown of five points, each point ensigned of a mullet, between in fess two roses argent, all between five roses, two, two and one, azure differenced by a label throughout dovetailed sable.

B. Awards and Honors

1. All persons who receive armigerous awards must be current paid members of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc., as listed in the corporate registrar's database of membership.
2. It is the right of any citizen to recommend to the Crown any person for any honor or Order in Trimaris.

C. General Award Rules

1. When an individual receives an armigerous award, s/he will automatically receive those arms which accompany the award, unless s/he already holds arms of such precedence.
2. Changes and additions to the names, tokens, or heraldic bearings of Trimarian honors and orders due to heraldic restrictions are the responsibility of the Triskele Herald in concurrence with the Crown.
 - a) These corrections are not considered changes to Greater Kingdom Law.
3. The Kingdom of Trimaris recognizes the precedence of all foreign Awards within the SCA.

D. Peerage Orders and Patents of Arms

1. The Peerage of Trimaris consists of the Orders of the Chivalry, the Order of the Laurel, and the Order of the Pelican.

2. The Order of the Rose, bestowed upon former Consorts of Trimaris following completion of their reign, will bear a Patent of Arms.

E. Augmentation of Arms

1. At their pleasure the Crown may bestow this, the highest and rarest heraldic honor, to an individual or group who has rendered outstanding service to the Kingdom or has brought honor to Trimaris through their efforts, and in all ways personifies what it means to be Trimarian.

F. Ordered Grants

1. The Order of the Triskele Trimaris (O.T.T.) is the premier Kingdom honor given for exemplary service to the Kingdom as a whole in any area of endeavor and exemplary courtesy.
 - a) Token, azure, triskele argent.
2. The Order of the Argent Sword of Trimaris (O.S.T.) is the premier fighting award and is given for excellence in, education in, and the fostering of heavy weapons combat.
 - a) Token, azure, a triskele between three swords in pall points to center argent.
3. The Order of the Silver Trident Trimaris (O.S.T.T.) is the premier Arts and Science award for excellence in any Art or Science and exemplary courtesy.
 - a) Token, azure, trident argent.
4. The Order of the White Scarf of Trimaris (O.W.S.T.) is awarded for the highest level of skills and training in light weapons combat. The Crown, pursuant to treaty with Ansteorra and the Outlands, bestows it. (White Scarf of Trimaris is the registered name for the Cravat Blanche.)
 - a) Token, a white scarf, worn about the left shoulder.
5. The Order of the Arc d'Or (O.A.O.) is awarded for the highest level of skill and training in archery, in combat or at the butts.
 - a) Token, azure, a bow fesswise Or between three triskeles one and two argent.
6. The attainment of Territorial or Court Baronage carries a Grant of Arms.
7. The Crown may bestow an unordered Grant of Arms.
8. The Order of the Golden Lance of Trimaris (O.G.L.) is awarded to those who have shown exceptional expertise in the equestrian arts and activities, and through continuing service has advanced and promoted the same. The Crown, pursuant to treaty with Ansteorra, bestows it.
 - a) The Queen of Trimaris will be the patroness of it.
 - b) Token, Azure, a semy of triskeles argent a jousting lance Or.

G. Kingdom Armigerous Awards

1. The Order of the Argent Scales of Trimaris (O.A.S.T.) may be bestowed for excellence in administrative service.
 - a) Token, argent scaly azure.
2. The Order of the Trade Winds of Trimaris (O.T.W.T.) may be bestowed for enduring and exemplary service in the Arts and Sciences.
 - a) Token, argent, an aeolus azure.
3. The Order of the Silver Shield of Trimaris (O.S.Sh.T.) may be bestowed for personal excellence in any martial art, including heavy and light weapons, archery, and live weapons.
 - a) Token, argent, on a triskele azure an escutcheon argent.
4. The Crown may bestow an unordered Award of Arms (AoA) to those persons deemed worthy by their service or accomplishment.

H. Baronial Armigerous Awards

1. The Order of the Wyvern's Claw (O.W.C.) will be the premier service award of the Barony of Wyvernwoode.
 - a) Token, Vert a wyvern's foot inverted coupé contourné argent.
2. The Order of the Cross and Serpent (O.C.S.) will be the premier service award of the Barony of An Crosaire.
 - a) Token, (Fieldless) A saltire coupé sable involved by a snake facing sinister vert armed and langued gules.
3. The Order of the Trident Keype (O.T.K.) will be the premier service award of the Barony of Darkwater.
 - a) Token, on an escallop inverted Or, a castle of three towers gules.

4. The Order of the Beacon of Oldenfeld (O.B.O.) will be the premier service award of the Barony of Oldenfeld. It may be given to any citizen for personal and exemplary service to Oldenfeld. It may be given more than once to the same person. At the discretion of the Crown of Trimaris, it may convey an Award of Arms.
 - a) Token: Vert, within a border a lighthouse Argent enflamed Or.
5. The Order of the Golden Citadel of Marcaster (O.G.C.M.) will be the premier award for the Barony of Marcaster
 - a) May be awarded more than once to an individual.
 - b) Token: Azure, issuant from the battlements of a demi-tower a beacon Or enflamed proper, a tierce wavy paly wavy argent and azure.

I. Kingdom Non-Armigerous Awards

1. The Crown of Trimaris may bestow non-armigerous Orders as They see fit.
 - a) Bestowal of these Orders does not affect a person's precedence in any way.
2. Unless otherwise noted, Kingdom non-armigerous awards may not be given more than once per reign to the same person.
3. The Order of the Trimarian Gratitude (O.T.G.) may be bestowed for service to the Sovereign at his/her discretion.
 - a) Token, barry wavy azure and argent, a triskele within a bordure Or.
4. The Order of the Emerald Seas (O.E.S.) may be bestowed for service to the Consort at her/his discretion.
 - a) Token, barry wavy vert and argent, a triskele within a bordure Or.
5. The Order of the Grey Beard (O.G.B.) may be bestowed to active fighter's age forty or over.
 - a) Token, per pale sable and azure, in saltire a crutch Or and a sword inverted proper, in chief a pair of eyeglasses argent stringed Or.
 - b) This award is not subject to the provision of Greater Law I:2.
6. The Order of the Argent Estoile (O.A.E.) may be bestowed for excellence in the Arts or Sciences in specific areas of endeavor.
 - a) Token, quarterly azure and vert, an estoile, a bordure embattled argent.
7. The Order of the Argent Palm (O.A.P.) may be bestowed for enduring and continuing service in any field of endeavor.
 - a) Token, azure, a palm tree coupé within a bordure argent.
8. The Order of the Argent Morning Star of Trimaris (O.A.M.T.) may be bestowed for promise in the martial arts, including heavy and light weapons, archery, and live weapons.
 - a) Token, Azure a morningstar bendwise within bordure argent.
9. The Order of the Trefoil Argent of Trimaris (O.T.A.T.) may be bestowed for exemplary courtesy, chivalry and period presence.
 - a) The Crown may bestow only two per reign.
 - b) Token, Argent, on triskele vert trefoil argent.
10. The Order of the Bards Laureate (O.B.L.) may be bestowed for service as Poet, Troubadour, or Mask Laureate Trimaris.
 - a) Token, (Fieldless) A joscelyn wreathed azure and argent, belled argent.
11. The Order of the Fletcher (O.F.), formerly known as the Order of the Sea Urchin, may be bestowed for service by children under the age of 16.
 - a) Token, (Fieldless) Four Japanese arrows notches conjoined in saltire bases to center azure.
 - b) This award is not subject to the provision of Greater Law I:2.
12. The Crown's Order of Gratitude (C.O.G.) may be bestowed for service to the Sovereign and Consort of Trimaris.
 - a) Token, per pale azure and vert, a triskele within a bordure Or.
13. The Order of the Mermaids Pearl (O.P.M.) may be bestowed for exemplary and continued service by those gentles over the age of fifty.
 - a) Token, Argent, a hand mirror azure silvered argent.

- b) This award is not subject to the provision of Greater Law I:2.
- 14. The Order of the Golden Galleon (O.G.G.) may be bestowed for exemplary service as an autocrat or head cook.
 - a) Token, Azure, a galleon Or.
 - b) This award is not subject to the provision of Greater Law I:2.
- 15. The Order of the Herald's Treasure (O.H.T.T.) may be bestowed for exemplary and continued service as a herald.
 - a) Token: (Fieldless) On a maunch azure semy of triskeles argent.
 - b) This award is not subject to the provision of Greater Law I:2.
- 16. The Order of the Healer's Lamp (O.H.L.) may be bestowed for exemplary and continued service as a surgeon.
 - a) Token: Azure, on a lamp Or a fleam gules.
 - b) This award is not subject to the provision of Greater Law I:2.
- 17. The Order of the Watchful Flame (O.W.F.) may be bestowed for exemplary and continued service as a constable.
 - a) This award is not subject to the provision of Greater Law I:2.
 - b) Token, Argent, eight flames in annulo bases to center azure.
- 18. The Order of the Silver Saddle Trimaris (O.S.Sa.T.) may be bestowed for personal excellence in any aspect of the equestrian arts.
 - a) Token, Per fess azure and vert a Tournament Saddle argent.
- 19. The Order of the Cross of St. Joan (CSJ) may be bestowed to a veteran heavy-weapons fighter who is found to be an inspiration both on and off the field of combat.
 - a) This award is traditionally given to female fighters.
 - b) Token: Azure, on a cross flory between four flurs-de-lys points to center argent, a triskele azure.
- 20. Order of the Rainbow Argent (ORA)
 - a) Given for promise in the Arts and Sciences
 - b) Token: Azure, a rainbow argent.
 - c) This order is closed.
- 21. Order of the Trimarian Weapons Master (OTWM)
 - a) Given for proficiency in a particular weapon style.
 - b)Token: Per fess argent and azure, in fess a Danish axe and a dagger argent.
 - c) This order is closed.
- 22. Order of the Black Widow (OBW)
 - a) Given to female fighters over the age of 35.
 - b) Token: Argent, on a spider inverted sable, a triskele Or.
 - c) This order is closed.
- 23. Order of the Quiver (OQ)
 - a) Given for promise in combat archery.
 - b) Token: Argent, on a quiver with three arrows azure a triskele argent.
 - c) This order is closed.

J. Baronial Non-armigerous Awards

- 1. Unless otherwise noted, the authority to bestow these awards is hereby granted to the Territorial Nobility of the listed Barony
- 2. The Order of the Wyvern's Scale (O.W.S.) may be bestowed for service to the Barony of Wyvernwoode.
 - a) Token, TBD
- 3. The Order of the Wyvern's Heart (O.W.H.) may be bestowed for excellence and devotion to the martial arts in the Barony of Wyvernwood.
 - a) Token: Vert, a tricopterate wyvern to sinister argent.
- 4. The Order of the Serpent's Gem (O.S.G.) may be bestowed for promise in the arts or sciences to the Barony of An Crosaire.

- a) Token, TBD
5. The Order of the Serpent's Torque (Ordo Torquis) (O.S.T.A.) may be bestowed for service to the Barony of An Crosaire.
- a) Token, (Fieldless) A snake in annulo lozengy vert and Or.
6. The Order of the Plume of the Angel Rouge (O.P.A.R.) may be bestowed for service to the Canton of Mathom Trove of the Barony of An Crosaire.
- a) Token, (fieldless) a feather gules.
7. The Order of the League of the Hidden Treasure (O.L.H.T.) may be bestowed for service to the Barony of Darkwater.
- a) Token: Sable on a plate between four escallops inverted Or, a trident head gules, all within an orle argent.
8. The Order of the Acorns Glade (O.A.G.) may be bestowed for promise in the arts or sciences to the Barony of Darkwater.
- a) Token (Fieldless) Four oak leaves in cross, stems to center gules, and four acorns in saltire, caps to center Or all conjoined at the center point.
9. The Order of the Darkwater's Defender (O.D.D.) may be bestowed for promise in the Martial Arts in service to the Barony of Darkwater.
- a) Token: Barry wavy sable and argent, a trident head gules.
10. The Order of the Lion's Paw of Oldenfeld may be bestowed for personal excellence in, fostering of or advancement of any endeavor pertaining to the Marshal Arts. This award may be given to any paid member. It may be given more than once to the same person.
- a) Token: Vert, within a bordure argent, a lion's paw Or.
11. The Order of the Silver Acorn of Oldenfeld may be bestowed for personal excellence in, fostering of or advancement of any endeavor pertaining to the arts or sciences. This award may be given to any citizen. It may be given more than once to the same person.
- a) Token: Vert, within a bordure, an acorn argent.
12. The Order of the Golden Standard (O.G.S) may be bestowed by the Baronial Coronet of the Barony of Marcaster for service and/or excellence in the Martial Arts.
- a) May be awarded more than once to an individual.
- b) Token: Azure, issuant from the battlements of a demi-tower a banner Or, a tierce wavy paly wavy argent and azure.
13. The Order of the Golden Hearth (O.G.H.) may be bestowed by the Baronial Coronet of the Barony of Marcaster for fostering and/or excellence in the Arts and Sciences.
- a) May be awarded more than once to an individual.
- b) Token: Azure, a brazier Or enflamed proper, a tierce wavy paly wavy argent and azure.
14. The Order of the Golden Well (O.G.W.) may be awarded by the Baronial Coronet of the Barony of Marcaster for exemplary and/or continued administrative or logistical service.
- a) May be awarded more than once to an individual.
- b) Token: Azure, a natural fountain Or, a tierce wavy paly wavy argent and azure.

LESSER KINGDOM LAW

I. General

A. Pre-Existing Law

1. All prior Lesser Kingdom Laws not listed in this publication of law are hereby repealed.

B. Changes to Lesser Law

1. Proposed amendments, additions, or changes to Lesser Kingdom Law must be proclaimed at an official event and published in the Kingdom newsletter at the earliest opportunity.
2. The published change must contain the date and event at which the new law was proclaimed.

C. Interpretation

1. The interpretation of Kingdom Law is the duty of the Crown and the Kingdom Seneschal in consensus.

II. Responsibilities of the Populace

A. Pre-Seventeenth Century Clothing

1. Persons attending events must wear their best effort at pre-17th Century dress.

B. Smoking

1. Smoking of cigarettes is not medieval and is prohibited in Courts, meetings and at feast.
2. Smokers are responsible for the disposal of their cigarette butts in their personal ashtrays or in sand buckets provided for that purpose.

C. Live Steel

1. Live steel (excluding tableware, eating knives, utility knives or other small tools) may only be used at Society events for the purpose of ceremony, display, approved competition or approved theatrical performance.
2. A sheath and peace tie (securing the weapon in its sheath) is required for all live steel weapons.
3. Weapons of any kind must be kept out of the reach of children at all times and must be stored in a safe manner.

D. Minor children

1. All persons under the age of eighteen (18) attending Society events must do so in the company of their parents, legal guardians or parental representative.
2. The parent or legal guardian of any minor attending a society event must complete such paperwork as the Kingdom Seneschal deems necessary, prior to the event. Such paperwork may be required to be notarized.
3. Any minor under twelve (12) years of age must have on his or her person at all times while attending any Society event both his or her legal name and both the legal and SCA names of the parent or other responsible adult at the event.

E. Animals

1. Animals may accompany their owners to Society events to the extent the federal, state, and local laws and site regulations allow.
2. The owner of an animal will be held accountable for its actions.
3. The animal and the owner may be ejected from the event for just cause by the Autocrat or the senior Seneschal at the event.
4. Animals may not be brought into feast halls at any time.

F. Sanctions

1. The Kingdom Seneschal shall have the authority to enforce any sanction levied in the Kingdom of Trimaris, and may delegate that authority to their warranted deputies and local officers.

III. Sumptuary Law

A. Crowns, Coronets and Circlets

1. The King and Queen and the Crown Prince and Crown Princess may wear crowns of precious metal with points, ornamented as they see fit.
- 2) Dukes and Duchesses may wear coronets of precious metal or other material, whose points consist of strawberry leaves or fleur de lys, ornamented as they see fit, the overall height not to exceed four (4) inches.
- 3) Counts and Countesses (and those with alternate titles of the same rank) may wear embattled coronets of precious metal, ornamented as they see fit, the overall height not to exceed three (3) inches.
- 4) Viscounts and Viscountesses may wear embattled coronets of silver or other non-metallic material, ornamented as they see fit, the overall height not to exceed three (3) inches.
- 5) Bestowed Peers (Chivalry, Laurels, and Pelicans) may wear a circlet of precious metals or other material with one (1) protrusion above the band, with simple ornamentation, the overall height not to exceed two (2) inches or the top of the head or may wear a Coronet of precious metal or other material with protrusions of twelve spheroids or precious stones, ornamented as they see fit, the overall height not to exceed two (2) inches or the top of the head. Laurels may wear a Laurel Wreath meeting these standards.
- 6) Territorial Barons and Baronesses may wear Coronets of precious metal or other material with protrusions of

six spheroids or precious stones, ornamented as they see fit, the overall height not to exceed two (2) inches or the top of the head.

- 7) Court Barons and Baronesses may wear coronets of precious metal or other material with protrusions of six spheroids or precious stones, with simple ornamentation, the overall height not to exceed two (2) inches or the top of the head.
- 8) Persons with Grants of Arms may wear a circlet of any metal with no protrusions above or below the band, ornamented with a single precious stone, the overall height of which will not exceed one half (1 /2) inch.
- 8) Persons with Award of Arms may wear an unornamented circlet of any metal with no protrusions above or below the band, the overall height of which will not exceed one quarter (1/4) inch.

B. Other Regalia

1. Members of the Order of the Pelican may wear caps of maintenance of gules, turned plumetty argent goutte de sange.
2. Members of the Order of the Laurel may wear caps of maintenance of vert, turned argent.
3. Unadorned chains of gold are reserved for use by the Chivalry, but only if they have sworn their fealty to the Crown. Spurs of gold, simple white belts and simple white garters are reserved for use of the Chivalry.
4. White scarfs worn about the left shoulder are reserved for use by Dons of the Order of the White Scarf.
5. Persons holding Grants of Arms may wear a collar of badges.
6. Simple red belts are reserved for use by the direct associates of members of the Order of Chivalry.
7. Simple yellow belts are reserved for use by the direct associates of members of the Order of the Pelican.
8. Simple green belts are reserved for use by the direct associates of members of the Order of the Laurel
9. Red scarfs worn about the left shoulder are reserved for use by the direct associates of members of the Order of the White Scarf.

C. Heraldic Display

1. Single Supporters used in the display of Achievements or Arms, may be used by Bestowed Peers, individuals having a Grant of Arms and groups.
2. Paired Supporters used in the display of Achievements of Arms may be used by Royal Peers and those groups and individuals having been granted an Augmentation of Arms.
3. The flag of Trimaris, argent a fess wavy, three triskelions arrondy 1 and 2 azure, may be flown by any member of the populace of Trimaris.
4. A triskele azure is the official badge of Trimaris and may be worn by any member of the populace of Trimaris.
5. The armorial bearings of the kingdom of Trimaris are, Argent a fess wavy between two triskeles azure a crown of five points, each point tipped with a mullet argent, between, overall a laurel wreath counterchanged. Mantling azure and argent. Crest: on a wreath of the colors a crown of five points or. Supporters: Two three headed sea-dragons vert, two banners, dexter, Argent a fess wavy three triskelions arrondi 1 and 2 azure, a bordure or and sinister, Azure, in chief a crown and in base a Triskele argent, a bordure or. Motto: "Ex Subter Mort".
